

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP PARKS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Grass areas must not be used for roadway parking or other purposes, which may injure the turf or landscaping.
2. Trees, shrubs, hedges, wildflowers, or other flowers must not be picked, dug, broken, or injured in any way whatsoever.
3. Buildings, fences, fountains, benches, walls, posts, or signs must not be injured.
4. Paper, rubbish, glass bottles, cigarettes, or any other refuse must not be scattered and must be deposited in receptacles provided for that purpose. Do not leave any trash in or around containers; **take out everything you brought in.**
5. Fires may not be built or allowed anywhere in the Park: other than stoves and/or fire rings provided for that purpose and located by Washington Township.
6. Picnics are permitted only in locations stated on the reservation form. The reservation fee entitles your group exclusive use of the designated picnic shelter, but NOT the entire park area. Visitors will NOT trespass on private property surrounding the park.
7. Persons holding picnics shall clean up and remove all paper and other refuse upon final departure.
8. No person shall conduct himself/ herself within the Park so as to harass or annoy any other person using the Park for recreational purposes.
9. No littering or property damage (INCLUDES NAILING OR POSTING SIGNS).
10. Any group of 25 persons or more using Park facilities MUST obtain permission at least seven days in advance.
11. Any event of 25 or more MUST obtain one additional porta-potty for each grouping of 25 people or fraction thereof, at their own expense and provide the Township proof of the rental prior to the event.
12. Public meetings, camping, assemblages, or parades may not take place within the Park limits without written consent of Washington Township. This includes any organized group conducting activities of any kind within the Park areas.
13. A rate of speed exceeding 15 miles per hour is prohibited in the Park.
14. Fees: \$50.00 per day fee is required for pavilion or amphitheater rentals. In addition, a refundable deposit of \$100 to cover any violation of the above rules and regulations or additional costs that may be incurred. The decision as to the amount refunded, if any, is solely Washington Township's. Any amount required above that will be paid by the applicant immediately upon receipt from Washington Township. Remaining refund, if any, will be issued at the next Washington Township public meeting.
15. Absolutely no open fire grills or fryers to be under pavilion roof.
16. Do not move tables from under the pavilion roof. Any table moved is to be returned to its original location.
17. Do not dump any grease, oils, or food in trash receptacles, waterways or ground.
18. We make **no** guarantees as to the weather or conditions of/or at the Parks.
