

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING APRIL 16, 2013

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Patterson called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on April 16, 2013 at 4:00 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412. Those present were Vice-Mayor Feikles, Councilmen Pernisek, Glass and Councilwoman Campbell. Also present were Manager Anthony, Zoning Administrator Carcella, Community Development Specialist Deborah Anthony and Engineer Halmi. Visitors were Norman Willow and William Leone.

AGENDA It was voted on motion by Glass, seconded by Feikles, to approve the Agenda as presented.

APPROVAL Motion carried unanimously.

COUNCIL MINUTES It was voted on motion by Campbell, seconded by Pernisek, to approve the Council Minutes of April 2, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT The following checks presented for approval: General Fund #14601-14604, Sewer Fund #6471, payroll checks #10007, #15058-15063. It was voted on motion by Pernisek, seconded by Campbell, to approve the checks as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

SECRETARY'S REPORT Manager Anthony gave the following verbal report: The Road Crew continues to fill potholes and sweep anti-skid from the streets and roads, and a road assessment had been completed. The chlorine injection system at the Water Plant has been repaired. Manager Anthony has submitted a single grant application to Rep. Lucas' office for funding towards the proposed Route 99 Sewer Extension project. The Road Foreman, Hank Wescoat, will continue to be off for another two weeks on Worker's Compensation for injuries received in the accident of March 1, 2013. Charles Shreve has been hired for part-time temporary summer help at a rate of \$9.00 per hour and Gary Kersetter has been hired on a temporary-full time position on the Road Crew at a rate of \$15.00 per hour. It was voted on motion by Campbell, seconded by Pernisek, to approve said hiring of Shreve and Kersetter at said rates. Motion carried unanimously.

CORRESPONDENCE Manager Anthony presented the following correspondence: An invitation to the ECATO Presentation Dinner. No action required.

ZONING OFFICER'S REPORT Zoning Officer Carcella presented the Enforcement Report, involving 9 complaints.

NEW BUSINESS

ZONING OFFICER Manager Anthony informed Council that Zoning Officer Terry Carcella will retire May 31, 2013.
RETIREMENT No action was required.

LEONE William Leone requested a waiver to leave in place the installed 48" culvert for his development on
WAIVER Edinboro Road. The said culvert was approved by PennDOT but does not meet the Township's
REQUEST Stormwater regulations for a 25-year rain event. Engineer Halmi discussed the calculations he used to determine the stormwater flows and informed Council that Mr. Leone's Engineer Rabell used different calculations when advising Mr. Leone. Engineer Halmi informed Council his calculations were based on the Township's rules and regulations. A lengthy discussion ensued. **It was voted** on motion by Feikles, second by Pernisek, to deny the waiver as presented. **Motion carried unanimously.**

MAYOR CHANGE Mayor Patterson left the meeting at 5:05, Vice-Mayor Feikles continued said meeting.
