

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING APRIL 17, 2012

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Feikles called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on April 17, 2012 at 4:00 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412. Those present were Vice-Mayor Glass, Councilmen Pernisek and Patterson and Councilwoman Campbell. Also present were Manager Anthony, Community Development Specialist Deborah Anthony and Zoning Administrator Carcella. Visitors were Don Clawson and James Kirk.

AGENDA It was voted on motion by Campbell, seconded by Pernisek, to approve the Agenda as presented.
APPROVAL Motion carried unanimously.

COUNCIL MINUTES It was voted on motion by Pernisek, seconded by Campbell, to approve the Council Minutes of April 3, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT The following checks presented for approval: General Fund #14049-14056, Sewer Fund #6282 and payroll checks #10000205, #995978-995982. It was voted on motion by Glass, seconded by Patterson, to approve all the checks as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

SECRETARY'S REPORT Manager Anthony gave a verbal report on the Road Crew's ditching on Skyview Drive; the crew will soon be moving to Crane Road and then to the Lakeside area. Manager Anthony informed Council that residents would be calling concerning this maintenance work as it has not been done for over 20 years. Manager Anthony also discussed the Township roads' weight limits that are in place and issues with contractors ignoring said postings. A gate has been installed at the entrance to Wainer Park because of all the vandalism this park receives. The gate will be open daily, and the GM Girl's Soccer team will be practicing in this park. Gravel has been delivered to Florek Road but has not been spread. More 2-RC gravel will need to be purchased.
