

## WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING – JULY 1, 2008

**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Foulkrod called to order the Public Hearing for proposed Ordinance #3-08 at 7:01 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building, 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412 on July 1, 2008.

**RULES FOR COMMENT** Mayor Foulkrod explained that persons wishing to comment should stand, state their name, and to direct their comments to Council. The purpose of this hearing to receive public comment.

**PROPOSED ORD. #3-08** Proposed Ordinance #3-08 provides the vacating a portion of undedicated Park Avenue right-of-way at the request of the adjoining property owners petition, in the Lake Isle Estates and the Lakeside Cliffs subdivisions in Washington Township.

**ADVERTISEMENT COPY** Manager Anthony presented a copy of the advertisements for this Public Hearing.

**WRITTEN COMMENT** None.

**PUBLIC COMMENT** Manager Anthony stated he received a verbal approval for the said vacating from an adjoining property owner John Liguori, who lives out of town. Comments were received from William and Betty Dilla, Walt Harman, Judy Walkiewicz, Jane Watt, Michelle Roberts. William and Betty Dilla stated there is an issue of stormwater run-off on their property located on the corner of Bonnieview Drive and Angling Roads from the Township's roads. Mr. Dilla requested compensation for said run-off. Councilman Glass reminded Mr. Dilla Council was hearing public comment for the vacating of Park Avenue at this Public Hearing, and Mr. Dilla had signed the said petition in agreement with the request.

**SOLICITOR'S COMMENTS** Solicitor Burroughs asked Zoning Officer Carcella if he reviewed Park Avenue to ensure that no requests have been received from the developer requesting the Township maintain the road or if any maintenance has been performed by the Township on said road during the last 21 years; Carcella replied no. Solicitor Burroughs asked Manager Anthony if there has been any use of said street Or if the Township lays claim to said street; Anthony replied no.
