**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Feikles called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on June 19, 2018 at 4:00P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412. Those present were Vice-Mayor Campbell, Councilman Patterson, Pernisek and Glass. Also present were Manager Anthony, Community Development Specialist Deborah Anthony and Zoning Norman Willow. **AGENDA** It was voted on motion by Campbell, seconded by Patterson, to approve the agenda as presented.  
**APPROVAL** Motion carried unanimously.

**COUNCIL MINUTES** It was voted on motion by Campbell, second by Patterson, to approve the Minutes of the July 3, 2018 Council Meeting as presented. Voting in favor were Campbell, Pernisek, Feikles, and Patterson. Abstaining was Glass. Motion carried.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT** Manager Anthony gave the following verbal report: the Lewis Road culvert project has been completed, with the clean-up work underway. The cost estimate for the project was \$150,000.00, but costs are projected to be under the estimate. A special thanks to Showman Excavating for their assistance and equipment to get the project completed in a timely manner. also, a thank you to Edith Ghere for allowing the Township employees use her property to park Township equipment during construction. Two civil suits have been filed with the District Justice to collect unpaid street light taxes. The Leacock Bridge passed the yearly inspection.
