

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING – AUGUST 2, 2011

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Glass called to order the Public Hearing for proposed Ordinance #2-11 at 7:30 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building, 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412 on August 2, 2011.

VISITORS Visitors were Dennis Porto, Gail Stickner, and Chris Roth.

RULES FOR COMMENT Mayor Glass explained that persons wishing to comment should stand, state their name, and to direct their comments to Council. The purpose of this hearing to receive public comment.

ORD. #2-11 STORMWATER MGT. Ordinance #2-11 amends Chapter 112 of the Washington township Code to assure safe management of stormwater run-off resulting in land alterations and disturbance with watershed stormwater management plans adopted pursuant to the PA Stormwater Management Act.

ADVERTISEMENT COPY Manager Anthony presented a copy of the advertisement for this Public Hearing.

WRITTEN COMMENT Written comment was received from Brian Zimmerman of the Edinboro Lake Watershed Association asking Council to reconsider Council's decisions regarding riparian buffers.

ORAL COMMENT Solicitor Burroughs reported that a copy of the proposed ordinance has been supplied to the County Law Library. Councilman Patterson stated the proposed ordinance was too complicated, lengthy and restrictive. Mayor Glass stated it was hard to read and understand. Gail Stickner asked Council if this ordinance was necessary and doable.
