CALL TO ORDER Mayor Feikles called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on May 18, 2021 at 4:30 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA. Trucking dirt from Gibson Hill to Edinboro Volunteer FD property, behind EH39, in preparation of the retention pond dyke construction. Zessinger Road cross-pipe replacement to begin Wednesday. Crack filling was completed on Monday May 17th. **It was voted** on motion by Campbell, second by Renick, to approve changing holidays from the 2 election days to the Friday before Labor Day weekend and the Friday after Thanksgiving. **Motion carried unanimously.**
