

## WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING – JUNE 1, 2021

**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Feikles called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on June 1, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA 16412. Those present were Vice-Mayor Renick, Councilperson Campbell, Councilperson Laythe and Councilmen Tim Dillen. Also present were Manager Anthony, Assistant Manager Willow, and Zoning Officer Lovell. Visitors were Darryl Parker, Scott Rastetter and Matt Tighe.

**AGENDA** **It was voted** on motion by Renick, second by Laythe, to approve the Agenda as presented.

**APPROVAL** **Motion carried unanimously.**

**COUNCIL MINUTES** **It was voted** on motion by Campbell, second by Renick, to approve the Minutes as presented for the Council Meeting of May 18, 2021. **Motion carried unanimously.**

### ASSISTANT MANAGERS REPORT

The Zessinger Road pipe replacement is complete. Road crew did a really good job, pipes were in, leveled and partially backfilled by 10:30. Repairs have been made to the siren on Crane Road. Installed a limit switch and replaced two batteries (100amp hour), totaling approximately \$730, including \$90.00 for installation. *The Disaster siren is up and running normally as it should. The odd sound it made has now been fixed. It's now extremely loud. The technician stated those batteries should be replaced every 4-5 years if you want to create a replacement plan for them.* -- Andrew Pennock Deiss & Halmi submitted several permit applications to ECCD on behalf of EVFD for the stormwater pond. Road crew hauled approximately 115 loads of dirt. There is sufficient soil for the damn as well as filling the existing stormwater ponds about ½ full (remainder of ponds will be filled with gravel). The speed enhancement sign is currently placed on Draketown road, just North of Leacock. Discussed *Savvy Citizen* or similar app with Council; declined at this time due to no citizen requests.
